

Health Screening Benefit

This benefit helps you pay for part of the expense of preventive medical tests you may normally have each year. The benefit allows a maximum of 1 health screening test per covered person per calendar year.

Tests that qualify:

Blood test for triglycerides	Flexible sigmoidoscopy
Bone marrow testing	Hemoccult stool analysis
Breast ultrasound	Mammography
CA 15-3 (blood test for breast cancer)	Pap smear
CA 125 (blood test for ovarian cancer)	PSA (blood test for prostate cancer)
Carotid Doppler	Serum cholesterol test to determine level of HDL and LDL
CEA (blood test for colon cancer)	Serum protein electrophoresis (blood test for myeloma)
Chest x-ray	Skin cancer biopsy
Colonoscopy	Stress test on a bicycle or treadmill
Echocardiogram (ECHO)	Thermography
Electrocardiogram (EKG, ECG)	ThinPrep pap test
Fasting blood glucose test	Virtual colonoscopy

The covered person must incur a charge and the certificate must be in force for benefits to be payable. A 30-day waiting period must be met.
